



Discussion: ADA Improvements to Middle School Campus

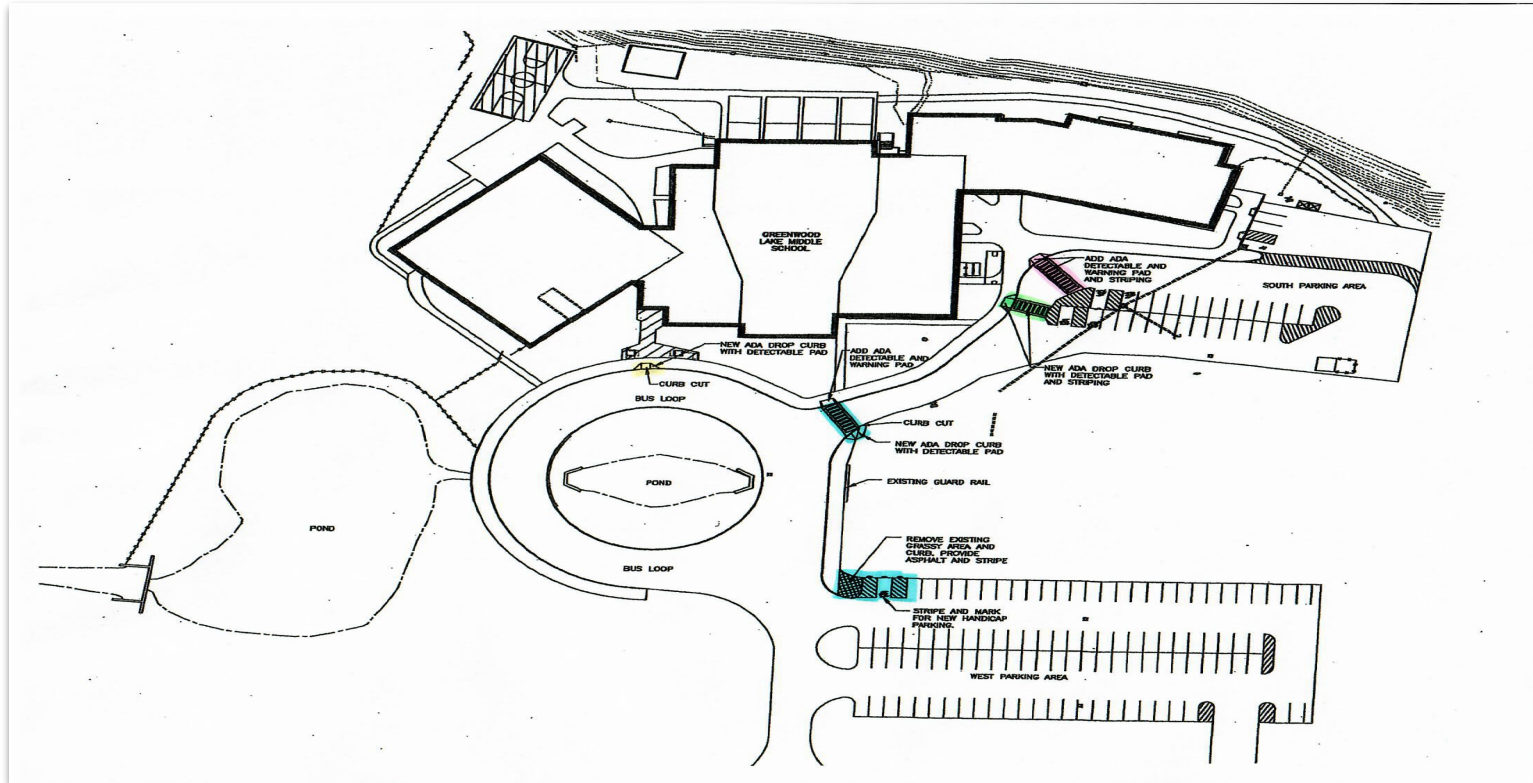
Discussion

In light of the a resident's request to add ADA access points to the Middle School campus, the Facilities Committee requested information to make the following recommended sidewalk improvements:

Add 4 additional access points:

- 1) Adding ADA accessible curbs to both sides of the walkway crossing the creek.
- 2) Cutting out an ADA curb in the bus circle.
- 3) In the lower lot, creating a designated crosswalk from the handicap parking area to the curb - cutting out a ADA curb.
- 4) In the lower lot, adding crosswalk hashing from the handicapped parking area to the Evening Event Entrance (4/5 wing).

Locations of Proposed Middle School ADA Ramps



The quote for the 4 ADA Ramp Improvements:

1) ADA Site Work at West Parking Area and Bus Loop	\$17,600
2) New ADA Drop Curb and Detectable Pad at Front Entrance Bus Loop	9,900
3) New ADA Drop Curb, Detectable Pad and Striping at South Parking Lot	13,200
4) Add ADA Detectable Pad and Striping at South Parking Lot Delivery Area	<u>2,750</u>
Sub-total	\$43,450
Contingent (5%)	<u>2,170</u>
Total	\$45,620

If approved, the project would take approximately 11 weeks.

- 1) 4 weeks for drawings, specifications and bid package.
- 2) 3 weeks to go out to bid and bid review
- 3) 2 weeks to gain Board of Education approval and sign contracts
- 4) 2 weeks for submittals from the contractor to the engineer for materials
- 5) Then construction would start but is weather dependent.
