



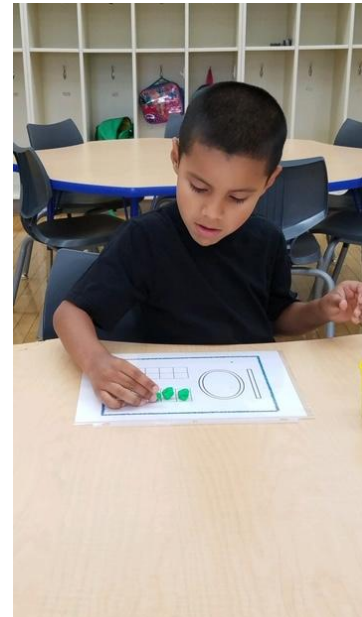
Bridging To



- (2) 3-week sessions, low class sizes of 7-9 students, targeted skill instruction
- 17 of 36 students selected using DIAL 4 and NWEA screening in June; 14 accepted our invitation to participate
- Goal: to prepare students for academic success by furthering their development of kindergarten readiness skills

Multi-Sensory, Targeted Skill Development for students in:

- Phonemic Awareness using *Foundations* resources
- Number Sense using the Abacus manipulatives and 10-frames
- Writing readiness of first name
- Gross and Fine Motors
- Appropriate class behavior
- Self-help
